



Work resumes on the I-25 North Express Lane Project in Adams and Broomfield counties March 2019

What is happening on the project?

The Colorado Department of Transportation and contractor partner, Graham Contracting Ltd., will improve I-25 between 112th Avenue and Northwest Parkway/E-470. Work includes resurfacing, installing concrete median barrier, technology improvements, and installing tolling infrastructure for the new Express Lanes.

Why is the project being built?

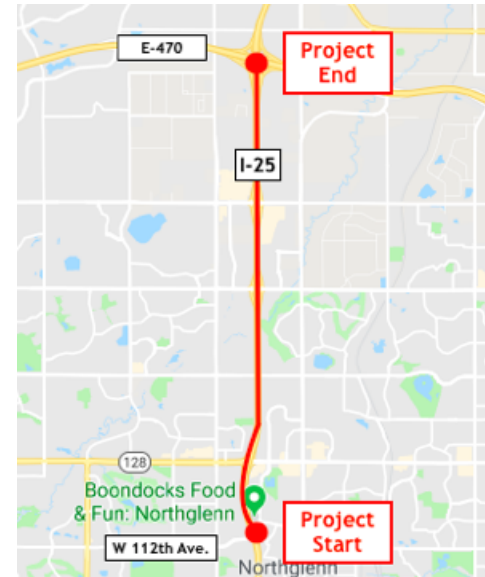
The project will complete the I-25 North Express Lanes from 120th to Northwest Parkway/E-470. There will be an Express Lane in each direction, which will increase mobility and travel choices along this busy stretch of highway connecting downtown Denver to major growth in northern Colorado. Travelers will have the choice of taking the three general-purpose lanes for free or the Express Lane for a quicker travel time in exchange for a variable toll. Improvements will improve travel times across all lanes and enhance safety.

When are crews working?

Daytime work will occur between 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Night work will occur between 9:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. during weekdays and from 9:30 p.m. to 9 a.m. during weekends.

Will there be road closures or traffic delays?

Motorists should expect various intermittent shoulder closures on I-25 during daytime work and two-lane closures on I-25 during night work. Traffic shifts should be expected 24/7 during this project.



Immediate travel impacts: From 3/24 to 3/30, two lanes on I-25 SB will be closed just north of CO 7 to 120th Ave from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Travel lanes will shift into a new configuration. One lane will remain open during this time. No lane closures during the day but there will be intermittent shoulder closures.

Work Expected from March to Fall 2019:

- Nighttime double-lane closures will commence 3/24; travel lanes will be shifted into a new configuration.
- Crews will begin installing median barrier.
- After crews install median barrier, they will work on sign caisson and light foundations.
- Following this work, the median barrier will be removed and replaced.
- Resurfacing and new pavement markings will be in place by early Fall 2019.

When should the project be complete?

Expected completion is end of summer 2020.
